Your voice

1 in 5 people in Illinois have a disability.

Your count

People with disabilities must be counted regardless of citizenship, age, or legal status - our lives depend on it.

The disability community deserves to be counted!

More than \$675 billion in federal funds are at stake.

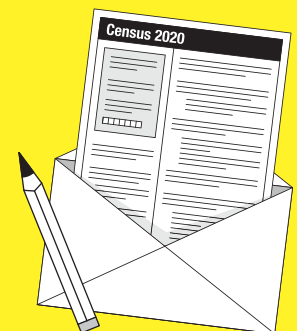
We lose at least **\$1,800 per year** on average nationally for each person undercounted in 2020. This means programs we rely on such as *healthcare services, energy and food subsidies, early childhood education, special education, accessible sidewalks, and even our highways* are at risk of funding cuts because of an undercount.



Be counted!

Around March 2020, you will receive an official mailing notification on how to complete the 2020 Census. **You can complete the mailed version sent to you or complete it online or by phone.** Fill out your form by **April 30th** to be counted.
